**„Exploring Biodiversity in Costa Rica: Scientific Opportunities and Collaborative
Potential“**

Costa Rica is a globally recognized biodiversity hotspot, with diverse habitats from sea level to mountains more than 3.000 m above sea level offering niches to numerous species of animals, plants and fungi. Although Costa Rica has a long, strong tradition of scientific investigation, there are still many open questions and opportunities for research in tropical ecosystems. The country combines a strong scientific infrastructure with an extensive national park system that protects a large portion of its territory. In addition, well-established biological collections and a solid community of experts in taxonomy and ecology provide an ideal foundation for high-quality research and international collaboration.
